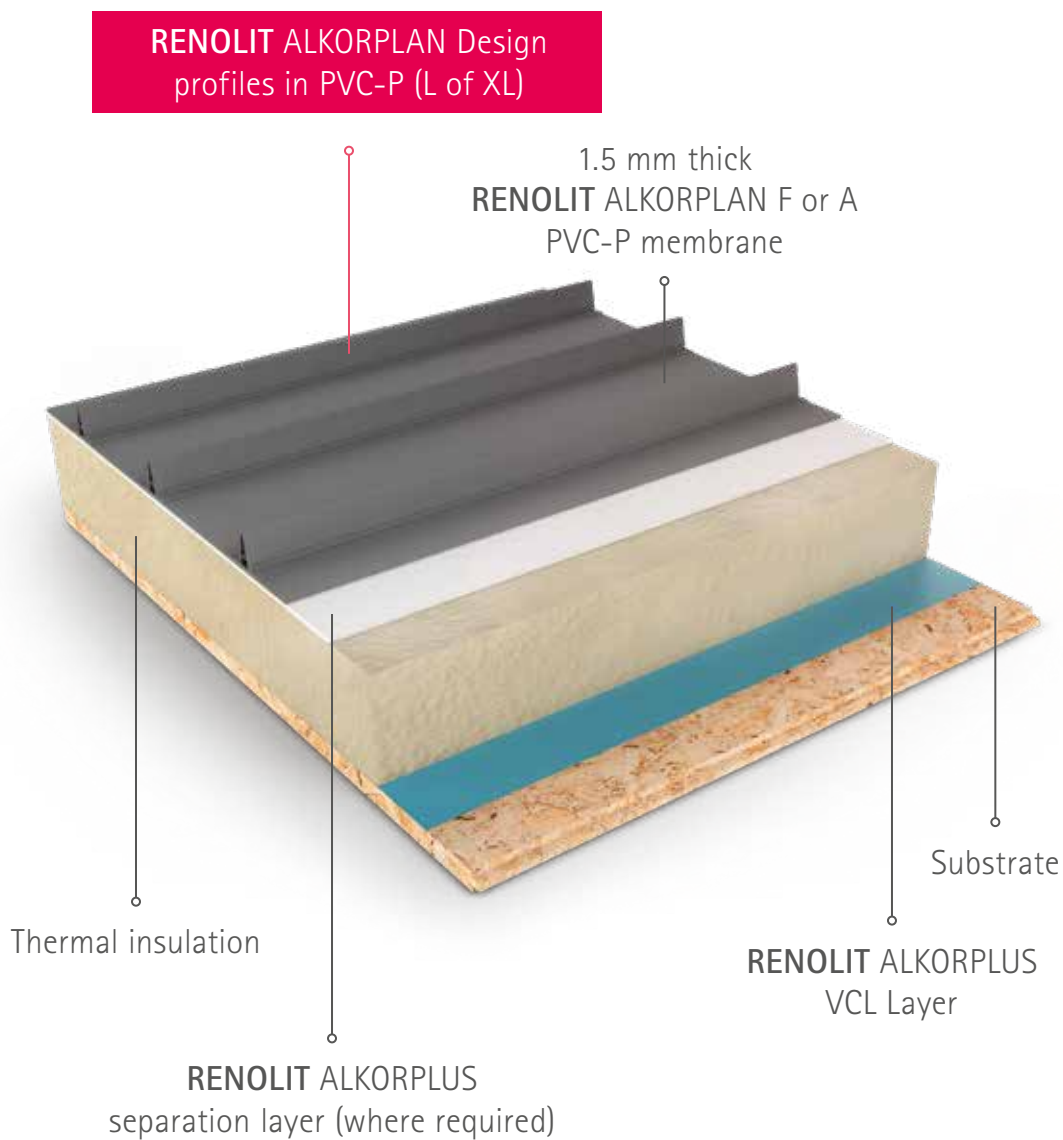

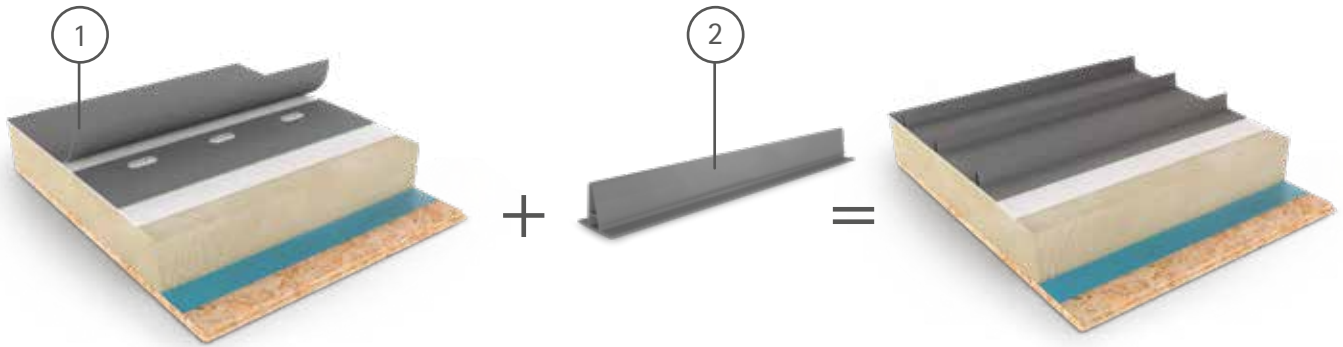

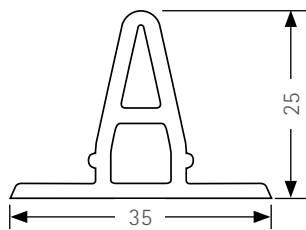
Perfect looks, reliability and longevity

The 1.5 mm thick PVC-P **RENOLIT ALKORPLAN F** roofing membrane with polyester reinforcement and **RENOLIT ALKORPLAN A** fleece-back membrane represent experience and quality. The extruded PVC-P profiles hot-air welded on top add the finishing touch. A purely aesthetic finish which is not detrimental to the waterproofing! For an installer, this finish will come as a breath of fresh air compared with the complexity of a metal roof with actual standing seams. This combined with a life expectancy assessed by the British Board of Agrément (BBA) up to 40 years.

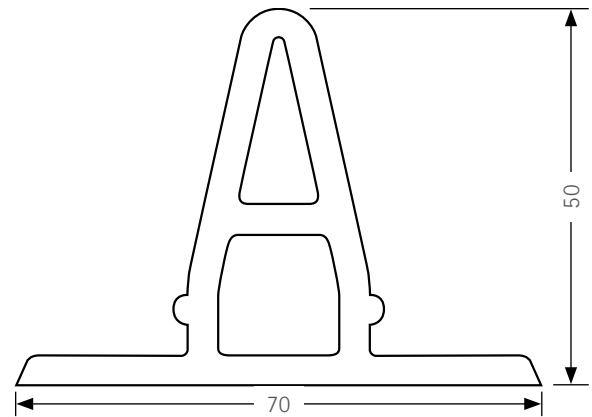

With the green of patinated copper, the grey of elegant zinc, striking terracotta or a refined anthracite, a roof may obtain a unique personality that goes well with the design of a building. Together with the RENOLIT ALKORPLAN Design profiles in L or XL, your roof also gains that typical standing seam look of a metal roof.

RENOLIT ALKORPLAN Metallics

If you want something even more eye-catching, you can choose a roof in shiny aluminium or trendy industrial copper, two striking colours with a special metallic surface. The corresponding profiles are available in L-format and have an even surface. If this colour range is not what you're after, we will look for another solution that is tailored to you. A custom-made colour is negotiable provided that certain conditions are met.

Our coloured roofing membranes comply with the $B_{roof}(t4)$ standard for pitched roofs. Contact RENOLIT for the terms and conditions.

Note: the geographic location of a building can be decisive for determining which colour may or may not be used.

Quick and easy to install

RENOLIT ALKORPLAN Design

As a roofing contractor you will no doubt be aware that a metal roof is not the easiest to install. This is something an architect is aware of too because experienced craftsmen for metal roofs are scarce. Owing to the complexity, the aesthetics, the durability and prevention of water ingress can be seriously compromised.

*In comparison, the **RENOLIT ALKORPLAN Design** system is a dream material for a roof installer. Even for the most complex challenges! Unlike metal roofs, installation itself is rather more straightforward and a less labour-intensive process. No time consuming fixing clips and distributor plates, and in particular no delicate standing seam finish with the guarantee of being watertight.*

Simple waterproofing

In the first instance, the roof is made waterproof with **RENOLIT ALKORPLAN** single ply roofing membrane, a product that is quick and easy to install and equally important, lightweight. The membrane is jointed with an overlap and sealed by means of hot air welding. Roof detailing is simple and fast.

RENOLIT has a wide range of matching roof accessories for this purpose (preformed angles, metal sheet, ...).

The impression of standing seam

The finish with standing seam is only applied once the roof has been fully sealed. **RENOLIT ALKORPLAN Design** profiles are positioned on the roof surface above the overlap. Spot welding every 5 to 10 cm facilitates the work and helps to prevent the profiles from moving. The two sides of the profile are then welded into place. The edges may be finished optionally afterwards with **RENOLIT ALKORPLAN PVC** seam sealer. Depending on the desired design, extra profiles may be added between overlaps or at specified centres.

Important! Always weld the profiles parallel to the roof incline for drainage purposes.

Maintenance

RENOLIT ALKORPLAN Design roofs require little in the way of maintenance. An annual inspection together with cleaning of the gutters and water outlets...nothing else!

Reliable waterproofing

Traditional metal roofs present a number of difficulties with regard to building physics. The consequences are not always good.

Metal roof versus RENOLIT ALKORPLAN Design

Excessive noise levels may be one such consequence of a metal roof. Hail and rain or expansion joint movement can lead to annoying noise. For this reason, the space beneath a traditional metal roof is not always habitable or insulation must be installed between the rafters which may lead to additional problems.

- In the case of a **RENOLIT ALKORPLAN Design** system, a warm roof solution is provided which means there is **little to no nuisance noise**. All spaces, even those directly below the roof, can therefore be used without any problem.

Another downside of metal standing seam on the roof is the risk of condensation. It is inherently vapour tight. Since provision has to be made for a ventilation opening beneath the metal, it remains difficult to keep these roofs free of condensation. Humidity, water droplets and moisture...does this leave you with an uneasy feeling?

- The **RENOLIT ALKORPLAN Design** system is not affected by this problem. **RENOLIT ALKORPLAN** roofing membrane is not only waterproof but in addition also **vapour permeable**. This means that the roof can continue to breathe. The risk of ventilation problems - and so condensation problems are virtually non-existent.

With metal roofs there are also expansion problems. Metal is subject to thermal expansion and so movement joints must be provided between the sections. The more expansion joints, the greater the chance of water leaks. For a complex roof shape, an expansion joint is also very difficult to execute correctly.

- The great benefit of a PCV roofing membrane is its **flexibility**. **RENOLIT ALKORPLAN** is not affected by changes in the ambient temperature. The roofing membrane can be installed continuously and to the desired length. No additional labour, no increased risk of leaks.
